## BYLAW NO. 2011/02/E

### **Amendment to Bylaw #2009/15/E**

**BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF DRAYTON VALLEY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND BYLAW 2009/15/E, BEING THE TOWN OF DRAYTON VALLEY LAND USE BYLAW.**

**WHEREAS** and pursuant to Section 63(1) of the *Municipal Government Act* 2000, being Chapter M.26.1 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, the Council of a municipality may be bylaw authorize the revision of all or any of the bylaws of the municipality.

**AND WHEREAS** Council deems it appropriate to introduce measures to reduce the consumption of water within the Town.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Town of Drayton Valley, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

#### 1. **Sustainability Charge**

As a measure to reduce the overall consumption of water, all consumers will be assessed a sustainability charge on the quantity of water consumed.

This charge shall be approved annually in the rates and charges schedule passed by Council resolution.

**AND THAT** this bylaw shall come into force and have effect from and after the date of third reading thereof.
