Amendment to Bylaw #2009/15/E

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF DRAYTON VALLEY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND BYLAW 2009/15/E, BEING THE TOWN OF DRAYTON VALLEY LAND USE BYLAW.

WHEREAS and pursuant to Section 63(1) of the *Municipal Government Act* 2000, being Chapter M.26.1 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, the Council of a municipality may be bylaw authorize the revision of all or any of the bylaws of the municipality.

AND WHEREAS Council deems it appropriate to introduce measures to reduce the consumption of water within the Town.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Drayton Valley, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. **Sustainability Charge**

As a measure to reduce the overall consumption of water, all consumers will be assessed a sustainability charge on the quantity of water consumed.

This charge shall be approved annually in the rates and charges schedule passed by Council resolution.

AND THAT this bylaw shall come into force and have effect from and after the date of third reading thereof.
