What to include in your Application

When applying for a Business License, you must provide:

- 1. Your municipal address;
- The legal description of your property (Lot, Block & Plan – these are available from your Tax Notice);
- Landowner consent to the operation of the business (if you are not the owner of the building);
- 4. A description of the business you propose and completion of an application for a business license, which includes:
 - a) Upgrades, expansions or alterations of existing structures and services;
 - b) Parking provisions;
 - c) Any proposed signage to be installed outside of the building

ALL PERMITS ARE SUBJECT TO A FOURTEEN (14) DAY APPEAL PERIOD.

Where to find the right information?

The Federal and Provincial governments have created a useful website which will help you determine what permits are needed, at all levels of government, to run your business.

What are the rules for businesses operating in Drayton Valley?

While these are not all of the regulations in place for operation of a business in Drayton Valley, they will provide you with some basic information:

- Proof a valid Provincial or Federal License, where required by law, are to be provided to the Town (this may include but not be limited to Health, Development, Building and/or Safety Code Permits);
- The Business License shall be posted in the business premises;
- The Business License may be revoked if there are just and reasonable grounds;
- The license may be revoked or suspended for non-compliance with a Bylaw;
- Subject to any/all Federal, Provincial or Municipal permits as required;
- Business License fees shall be paid on a yearly basis;
- Upon approval of the License Inspector and receipt of the required forms and fee for a change of name or location, a Business License may be transferred.

*Additional conditions apply to businesses operated from residential areas or operated as "home occupations"

IMPORTANT NOTE:

It can take between 2 and 3 weeks for a Business License to be processed, so get your application to the Town well before you plan to open your doors.

If you are putting a sign outside your business, even a portable sign, you need a permit.
